· Looking for mini beasts

The children have been interested in the small creatures that live in the garden. We have been going on mini beast hunts. We talked about being kind to the mini beasts, leaving them where they are with their families and not hurting them. We had spaghetti worms hidden in the compost in the tuff tray, the children used tweezers to pick them up and put them into pots.

Experimenting with water
