Acorn Project

We are pleased to inform you that the Acorn Project will now have regular drop-in sessions in the small hall at the Arbury Community Centre. They will be there every **Tuesday between 8-11am.** Here is some info from Rachael at Acorn:

We are a safe, confidential space for any parents or carers that could benefit from a little extra support. I am the hub coordinator and therapist. I work with children and families that have experienced trauma and abuse. My caseworker Nora is also a qualified therapist and can support families with housing and financial hardship. As a team we can support with issues around wellbeing, family difficulties, SEN, parenting strategies, life admin and referrals for therapy and legal advice. We have lovely volunteers that are trained in peer support and always on hand with a cup of tea. Parents are welcome to bring children in with them.
